Mr. Duke provided the staff report of the agenda item. He stated that the proposed post and rail wooden fence is requested to provide protection to the specimen Yaupon holly on the property. He stated that the proposed 1.5' x 6' sign would be internally lit located at the intersection of the creek walk.

Ms. Langley moved to separate the two items. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Item 1- Fence

Mrs. Langley stated that more options for the type fence as well as different option as a barrier for the tree. (Landscape, shrubs, or curbstop).

Mrs. Davis moved to table the item to allow the city to provide other options as a barrier for the tree. Mrs. Langley seconded the motion. The motion to table passed unanimously.

Item 2-Sign

Mr. Duke stated that the proposed sign does not meet the guidelines; however consideration must be given to its location away from the historic structure and its function as a directional/identification sign.

Mrs. Langley recommended tabling the item until the fence is resolved.

Mr. Barrett stated that he doesn't see any problem since there are like signs posted in the district.

Mrs. Langley moved to table the item until the next meeting. Mrs. Davis seconded the motion. The motion to table passed unanimously.
