



Garbage

Garbage is considered any household item such as food waste, bathroom articles, paper, pet waste, etc.

Garbage routes are run Monday through Friday and are picked up on either a Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday schedule in the areas without garbage cans. Garbage is picked up on Wednesday in the areas of the City with garbage cans.

Garbage should be placed on the curb by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled day of pick-up. Please do not put garbage out the night before the scheduled day of pick-up.

Do not mix garbage with trash. Different trucks are used to pick up various items.


Place all garbage in plastic bags. In the areas of the City without garbage cans, bagged garbage is not permitted to be placed in cans, boxes, or other containers, even if it is bagged.

Charges for Sanitation services will be included on your monthly water bill.

No batteries, oil, or other hazardous materials will be picked up.

Holiday Policy

The Sanitation Division observes the following holidays:

If a holiday falls on a Saturday, the City will observe it on Friday. If the holiday falls on a Sunday, the City will observe it on Monday. Routes not collected due to holidays will be picked up on an amended schedule posted to the city website.

The City of Prattville's Sanitation Division is responsible for the collection of the City's garbage and trash.

Mission Statement

The mission of the Sanitation Division is to maintain a safe, efficient, and effective waste collection and disposal system that meets the needs of the Prattville community and comply with all applicable regulations and standards. Through the directives of the Mayor and City Council, we will achieve this by:

- ◇ Developing and maintaining a highly professional and competent staff.
- ◇ Administering a solid waste management system, utilizing available resources that will provide general cleanliness to the City of Prattville.

Important Information

It is unlawful to throw, sweep, or otherwise deposit garbage or rubbish in any sewer, gutter, drainage way, or upon any curb, street, sidewalk or vacant lot. Violators are subject to arrest.



Trash (Yard Debris)

Trash is considered to be limbs, leaves, grass clippings, boxes, etc. and will be picked up one time per week in each neighborhood. Pick up in a neighborhood is completed before trash trucks move on to the next neighborhood.

No batteries, oil, or other hazardous material will be picked up.

Curbside pickup of large amounts of trash (yard debris) or other bulk items require a special collection. For bulk waste (Construction debris, mattresses, appliances, etc...) a collection charge will be assessed based on the current rate of disposal. This rate will be determined annually by the Director of Public Works. Where the quantity collected is less than a truck load, the collection charge will be prorated. Please contact the Sanitation Division Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at (334) 595-0621 to schedule a special collection.

Boxes must be broken down if possible, or smaller boxes placed within larger ones. All plastic or paper packing materials must be placed in a box and taped to prevent scattering.

Charges for Sanitation services will be included on your monthly water bill.

For safety, do not put loose, broken glass or any other sharp objects in the bags. Enclose these items in a box or other rigid container before placing them in with other garbage collection.

Charges for Sanitation services will be included on your monthly water bill.

Leaves, grass clippings, pine straw, etc. must be bagged between April 15th and October 1st.


Limbs and hedge clippings must be no larger than 8 in. diameter or 4 ft. long.

Stack in an orderly fashion near the curb, but not in the street, gutter or on the sidewalk. Avoid placing by a mailbox, utility pole or anything that will obstruct the use of equipment. No stumps or tree trunks will be picked up.

Debris left by tree surgeons, pulp woodcutters, roofers, construction workers, etc. will not be picked up. A current City business license is required by these business owners in order to perform services in the City of Prattville.

Recycling Center

Citizens may take recyclable items such as aluminum, paper, plastic, and cardboard to the recycling center located at 122 Ridgewood Road. This site is open Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Bagged Household garbage and Trash (yard debris) may be dropped off only on Saturdays during Recycling Center hours. City residents need to bring a current water bill to avoid charges. No bulk waste items will be accepted.

Recycling bins have been placed in the parking lot at Fire Station 3, 1904 Briarwood Street, which is located behind Wal-Mart. These bins are open to the public during daylight hours every day of the week. Citizens may drop off paper, cardboard, aluminum, steel or tin cans, and plastic with recycling codes 1 and 2.
