



Proclamation

By the Mayor of Prattville, Alabama

WHEREAS, firefighters are our unsung heroes who daily put their lives on the line to help their neighbors and keep the community safe; and

WHEREAS, firefighters must retain their composure in a variety of emergency situations while fulfilling requirements to perform the task at hand no matter how simple or critical the scenario; and

WHEREAS, occasionally, firefighters may have to remain at the scene of a disaster for days on end; and

WHEREAS, most firefighters remain on call during a shift for 24 hours where they routinely inspect equipment and perform practice drills to be prepared for duty; and

WHEREAS, Fire Prevention Week was established to commemorate the Great Chicago Fire, the tragic 1871 conflagration that killed an estimated 300 people, left 100,000 homeless, destroyed more than 17,000 structures and an estimated \$200 million in damages; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alabama Governor, Robert Bentley, signed a proclamation on April 15, 2015 proclaiming Alabama Firefighter Appreciation Day to occur each year on the Friday of Fire Prevention Week in October; and

WHEREAS, the state of Alabama and the City of Prattville are greatly indebted to the heroic and hardworking paid and volunteer firefighters.
