WHEREAS, Bill has been a charter member of the Prattville/Millbrook Sunrise Rotary since 2000 and has served as past president, past treasurer, and Paul Harris Fellow, the chair of the Prattville Baptist Hospital Board of Advisors from 2012-2014, the Chair of the Autauga County Volunteer Organizations Active in Disaster where he helped organize volunteers after the Prattville tornado in 2008, and a part of many other civilian associations.
